Chairman's Summary

The Governance Board of the Medicines Patent Pool (MPP) thanks the Expert Advisory Group (EAG) for its report assessing the final results of negotiations between the MPP and the University of Washington on a licence agreement for TLD long-acting injectable technology for HIV. Having reviewed the EAG Report as well as the proposed licence agreement, the Board agrees with the EAG's assessment that the proposed collaboration is consistent with the MPP's mandate as defined in its statutes and represents a significant improvement over the status quo.

Therefore, the Board requests the Executive Director to finalise and sign the necessary documents with the University of Washington to formalise the collaboration.
